

1. Perfective – focuses on completed actions.
2. Imperfective – focuses on ongoing or repeated actions.
3. Verb pairs express the same action either as a process or a completed task.
4. Perfective verbs are often formed by adding a prefix.
5. Sometimes prefixes also change the meaning, not just the aspect.
6. Imperfective versions can be formed by changing the suffix.
7. Perfective verbs cannot be used in the present tense.
8. Imperfective verbs can express all three tenses.
