- 1. Perfective focuses on completed actions.
- 2. Imperfective focuses on ongoing or repeated actions.
- 3. Verb pairs express the same action either as a process or a completed task.
- 4. Perfective verbs are often formed by adding a prefix.
- 5. Sometimes prefixes also change the meaning, not just the aspect.
- 6. Imperfective versions can be formed by changing the suffix.
- 7. Perfective verbs cannot be used in the present tense.
- 8. Imperfective verbs can express all three tenses.
