

Loanwords

In loanwords, "i" often does not soften the preceding "d, t, n" to "d', t', ň".

Most modern loanwords in Czech come from English. They usually keep their original written form, but their pronunciation is adapted to Czech rules.

When spoken, only Czech phonemes are used.
